Invitation to the 5th International Forum on “The Belt and Road Initiative & International Talents Nurturing - Entrepreneurial Universities in Industry 4.0”, 27 - 31 March 2020, Singapore

Warm greetings from Nanyang Technological University in Singapore.

Along with the rapid progress of the Belt and Road Initiative, there arise new challenges and demands for high-end international talents. The implementation and promotion of major projects along the Belt and Road Initiative call for even more close participation and contribution of international talents. Sponsored by the Tan Chin Tuan Foundation, the forum will create an important platform for academic leaders, senior administrators and entrepreneurs from the two countries to have candid, cordial and in-depth discussions on major trends in higher education and research, talent nurturing and innovative thinking in the higher educational setting in the era of Industry 4.0.


